

Department Enrollment Policy

Please be aware of the department's enrollment policies:

- The department will cancel your enrollment if you do not attend at least one of the first two class meetings (for classes that meet two days each week), or you do not attend the first class meeting (for classes meeting one day each week).
- Enrollment after the second day of class for classes that meet two days a week or the first day of class for classes that meet one day a week is not allowed. No exceptions.
- Geography 7 and 180 thru 187 are limited to Environment and Sustainability, Environmental Science, and Geography majors, and Geography and Geospatial Informational Systems and Technologies minors on the first enrollment pass.
- Geography 100 thru 179 are limited to Geography majors and minors on the first enrollment pass.
- Nonmajors may enroll in Geography 7, 100 thru 176, 180 and 183 thru 187 on the second pass (space permitting).





It is strongly recommended that you use your first pass enrollment appointment to secure a seat in impacted classes such as GEOG 7 or other Procedures courses. First pass enrollment begins 11/07/24. Second pass enrollment begins 11/14/24.

Reminders

- All major and minor courses must be taken for a letter <u>grade</u>. If you haven't already double check your grading basis.
- Make sure you are taking classes towards your major/minor requirements for a **LETTER grade** and not Pass/No Pass.

NOV 8- Last day for undergraduates to change grading basis on optional P/NP courses without fee or petition through MyUCLA
