UCLA Geography | Major/Minor Course Substitution Petition (rev. 25F)

GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION: Course substitutions are considered on a case-by-case basis. Eligible substitutions are approved to count toward the major/minor requirements if they I) are **letter-graded "B" or above** <u>and</u> 2) explicitly demonstrate or engage geographical approaches, theories, and scholarship. <u>Substitutions for lower division courses are not permitted.</u>

Pre- approval for courses is not provided.

The department allows up to a maximum of two (2) upper division courses completed <u>outside of the discipline of Geography</u> to count towards a GEOG major/minor with the Undergraduate Faculty Committee's approval. For Study Abroad courses taken in Geography departments and approved by UC Education Abroad (UCEAP), the number of upper division courses allowed is five (5) for majors and two (2) for minors. For Study Abroad courses from non-Geography departments and courses outside of the Department, there will be a maximum of two (2) upper division courses that can transfer to the majors and a maximum of one (1) upper division course that can transfer to the minor.

To petition a course, complete this form and submit with the proposed course's syllabus and/or reading list attached AFTER the course you have taken is reflected on your UCLA academic record or degree audit. The course's syllabus and/or reading list should include a) course description, b) required assignments and required readings (indicating # of pages per week), and c) the course schedule. If a syllabus is not available or does not include all the information requested (a - c), please supplement the details yourself on a separate sheet of paper and attach. Petitions are reviewed 2x's per quarter and typically take 3 - 4 weeks for a decision. Students may submit one petition per course completed. If the petition is denied, the decision is final.
